Instructions

- Watch lecture videos for each topic in succession. Each topic is broken down into two to three parts. The videos are available for you on demand to watch on your own schedule. You can re-watch as many times as you want to absorb the content.
- Each topic page also includes a download button to download the lecture PDF for your review.
- Every week on Friday at 3:00 PM West African Time (WAT), you will be required to join a zoom call with your instructor. The zoom link will be available in your module following the relevant topic covered during that week, according to the following schedule:
 - Topics 1,2 and 3 – Friday, May 17, 3PM WAT
 - Topics 4,5 and 6 – Friday, May 24, 3PM WAT
 - Topics 7,8,9 and 10 – Friday, May 31, 3PM WAT
 - Topics 11,12,13 and 14 – Friday June 7, 3PM WAT

Quizzes

- Each topic includes a five-question quiz. You can take the quizzes at any time during your cohort period, you DO NOT need to take the quiz immediately after you finish watching the video. However, You WILL need to take all the quizzes during the cohort period to be eligible for the certificate of completion.
- You will only be allowed one attempt on each quiz.

- You can access your interest group at any time. You are encouraged to use the forum to post questions about the course material. Your instructor will be checking the message board periodically throughout the week to answer your technical questions.
